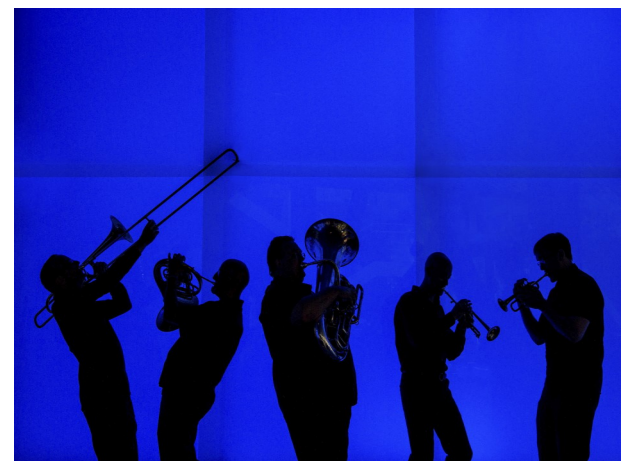
Klezmer Meets Gospel
