 [Based on the State Report covering the full year of 2019]

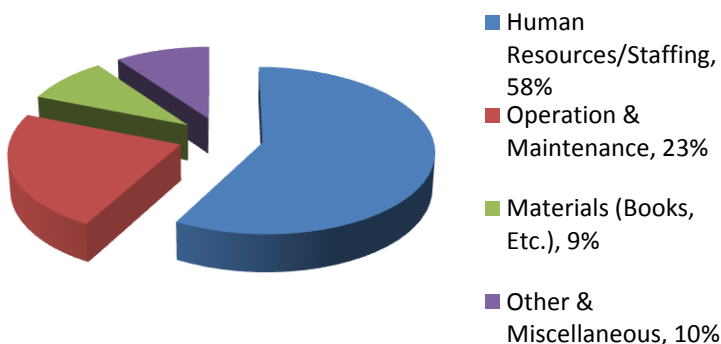
The library has now operated for a number of years with tax-based funding provided by a “414” vote, for about 85% of our budget, an immense help. The “414” vote does not occur every year. Facility repairs continue for improvements, replacements and additions (such as a new phone system, improved wifi capabilities etc.). We continue to update all materials in the library collection and have a major on-going book weeding program. Expanding our hours to seven days a week has been very popular. We have an amazing group of volunteers and committees (new members welcome!). E-book service, downloadable audio, movies, and classes have expanded. Children’s story times, reading programs, films, events and more continue. Check the events calendar on our website for a wide range of programs (www.eltinglibrary.org). Our local history collection has more on-line exhibits and more digitizing of material. The library remains a center of our community.
